

# Nevada Arts Council: Save Outdoor Sculpture! Collection CAE1206

#### **Introduction / Abstract**

This archive contains photographs and condition reports of sculpture in Nevada from Nevada Arts Council's involvement with Save Outdoor Sculpture!, a national survey of the outdoor sculpture sponsored by Heritage Preservation (The National Institute for Conservation) and the Smithsonian American Art Museum.

#### **Nevada Arts Council**

The Nevada Arts Council (NAC) is the Nevada State agency charged with ensuring that state and national funds support cultural activity and encourage participation in the arts throughout Nevada. Their vision is: A Nevada in which the arts enrich the lives of all residents, enhances the livability of communities, and contributes to the state's economic revitalization.

## **Scope and Content**

Save Outdoor Sculpture! is a national survey of the outdoor sculpture sponsored by Heritage Preservation (The National Institute for Conservation) and the Smithsonian American Art Museum. In each state there was a local partner, in Nevada that being the state arts agency, the Nevada Arts Council. Save Outdoor Sculpture! (SOS!) helps communities across the United States preserve and promote their sculpture. SOS! began in 1989 by involving 7,000 volunteers and state and local organizations to catalog and assess 30,000 publicly accessible outdoor sculptures. Of that total, 54 percent were determined to be in critical or urgent need of conservation to survive. The data is accessible via the Inventory of American Sculpture database at the Smithsonian American Art Museum.

The Nevada Arts Council staff and contractors documented 197 outdoor sculptures, including 59 in Las Vegas. The Nevada survey discovered that more than half of the state's outdoor sculpture had been created from the 1980s onwards. Works documented during the project ranged from the Civil War monument titled Nevada's Tribute to Union Soldiers and Sailors made in 1891 to Luis Jimenez's Vaquero at McCarran International Airport in Las Vegas and Michael Heizer's Double Negative, and more vernacular works such as Rod McCormick's Coffee Can Chicken in Fallon, Thunder Mountain in Imlay, and Guru Road north of Gerlach.
