

In addition to artworks, Dr. Richard Paltenghi also collects other items related to the artist Maynard Dixon, including rare books illustrated by the artist (upper and lower left). Above is a handwritten note to the artist Carl Oscar Borg from Dixon. To the right is a comical portrait of the writer Eugene Manlove Rhodes taken by Dixon in 1912.

The Paltenghi brothers were first introduced to Maynard Dixon when their father, Richard E. Paltenghi purchased the painting *Eagle's Roost* in 1964. This is his receipt from that original purchase. The painting hangs on the wall near the entrance of the exhibition.
