## Summer of Soul

The Summer of Soul was a historic musical event that occurred over the summer in Harlem ,NY between June 29 through August 24th 1969. Over 300,00 people attended, yet it received virtually no medica coverage from the mainstream media The event stood as a testament to the healing power of music during times of unrest, both past and present. The state of America in the summer of 1969 eerily resembles the state of the nation today. The musical festival had been filmed and yet remained unpublished for at least 45 years! That is until Questlove took up the honor of revealing a piece of history that needed to be shared. This film, his directorial debut, premiered this January at the Sundance Film Festival, where it picked up both the Audience Award and the U.S. Grand Jury Prize.
