NEVADA MUSEUM OF ART DEBUTS CURATED BOOK SHOP INSIDE NEW CHARLES AND STACIE MATHEWSON EDUCATION + RESEARCH CENTER

Reno, Nev. (August 22, 2025) — The Nevada Museum of Art is proud to announce the opening of the Bretzlaff Book Shop, a beautifully curated destination for art lovers, architecture aficionados, book collectors, and design enthusiasts. Located on the first floor of its newly-completed Charles and Stacie Mathewson Education + Research Center, the Bretzlaff Book Shop offers a thoughtful experience that complements the Museum's mission of connecting art, environment, and scholarly inquiry.

Designed as a companion to the new Thomas and Pauline Tusher Research Library on the first floor, the Bretzlaff Book Shop features a unique selection of art, architecture, and design volumes, as well as beautiful coffee table books. Visitors will discover a wide array of visually stunning and intellectually stimulating titles, including every art book published by the Nevada Museum of Art. These include editions highlighting the art of Maynard Dixon, Judith Lowry, Jean LaMarr and the popular 2015 exhibition *Tahoe: A Visual History*.

"The Bretzlaff Book Shop is a beautiful extension of our curatorial voice and showcases the Museum's commitment to publishing and scholarship," said David B. Walker, CEO. "The Charles and Stacie Mathewson Education + Research Center is an investment in our community and as part of that, we're thrilled to offer our guests an inspiring environment where inquiry, curiosity, research and knowledge are at the heart of every visit to the Museum."

Other notable books in the Bretzlaff Book Shop include a leather-bound edition of Julia Child's famous cookbook, architecture books highlighting the work of Frank Lloyd Wright, the Pantone color design book, Nike photo collage of the iconic Air Jordans, the legacy of Led Zeppelin and many more.

"The museum's goal was to create a place where your surroundings are as fresh and stimulating as the variety and quality of books," said Valerie Curtis, Director of Retail Operations. "No matter what kind of creative expression interests you, it's here."

The Book Shop is located on California Avenue in Reno and is open to the public during regular Museum hours: 10 am – 6 pm Tuesday through Sunday and 10 – 8 pm on Thursday.
