ARTISTS ANNOUNCED FOR *INTO THE TIME HORIZON*, NEVADA MUSEUM OF ART'S MOST EXPANSIVE EXHIBITION

Reno, Nev. (January 27, 2026) — The Nevada Museum of Art today announced the full roster of 193 artists featured in *Into the Time Horizon*, a landmark exhibition on view March 28–September 20, 2026. Spanning all 120,000 square feet of the Museum and organized across seven thematic sections, *Into the Time Horizon* brings together nearly 300 works of art, making it the most expansive exhibition in the Museum's history.

An international survey of environmental art, *Into the Time Horizon* invites visitors to consider how to shape a more resilient, ethical, and sustainable future in an era of accelerating environmental and social change. The exhibition foregrounds artists from many diverse ethnic backgrounds whose practices engage with land, ecology, extractive histories, Indigenous knowledge systems, regeneration, and collective responsibility across generations. Artists from South America, North America, Asia, Europe, and Australia are represented in the project.

Although there have been a range of international exhibitions exploring different aspects of environmentalism, *Into the Time Horizon* promises to be one of the most comprehensive presented by a U.S. institution. Including nearly 200 artists, the exhibition aims to shed insight into the wide range of output and media created by artists of all genders who are integrating environmentalism into innovative artistic approaches. Uniquely, this exhibition foregrounds Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists who have been largely marginalized in Western contemporary art contexts, including artists such as Maringka Baker, Lily Karadada, James Iyuna, Baluka Maumura, Judith Rowe Nakamara, Lily Kelly Napangardi, Naata Nungurrayi, Lin Onus, Gloria Tamerre Petyarre, Rene Sundown, and Regina Pilawuk Wilson, to mention just a handful.

Similarly, artists from areas that will be most heavily impacted by climate change are featured, including Marshallese artists Alson Kelen, Kathy Jetnil-Kijiner, Susan Jieta; African artists El-Anatsui, Wangechi Mutu, Otobong Nkanga, and Sanaa Gateja; Vietnamese artists Tiffany Chung, Tuan Andrew Nguyen, Tammy Nguyen, and Tuan Phan; Indian artist Rohini Devasher; as well as South American artists such as Carolina Caycedo, Bartolina Xixa, Ernesto Neto, Clarissa Tossin, and Ana Vaz. Additionally, artists who have been making environmentally-focused work for decades, but who have not yet received wide recognition are included such as Judith Belzer, Marilyn Bridges, Fandra Chang, Wanda Hammerbeck, Suzanne Husky, Isabella Kirkland, Haley Mellin, Joan Myers, Patrick Nagatani, Jamey Stillings, and Diane Tuft. Established artists—such as Mark Dion, The Harrisons, Pierre Huyghe, Liz Larner, and Alexis Rockman—who have been engaging with environmental issues over the course of their careers are also present. Additionally, artists who are celebrated in the Nevada region, but lesser known beyond the area, such as Jack Malotte, Nolan Preece, and Peter Goin are featured in the exhibition.

Notably, work by Indigenous artists comprises approximately 38 percent of the exhibition, reflecting the central role of Indigenous wisdom and their long-standing stewardship and protection of land and Country. First Nations artists from Australia, North America, and South America are present, including Aycoobo (Wilson Rodriguez), Teresa Baker, Rebecca Belmore, Beau Dick, Nicholas Galanin, Jeffrey Gibson, Cannupa Hanska Luger, Eric-Paul Riege, Abel

Rodríguez, Rose B. Simpson, Juane Quick-to-See Smith, Lawrence Paul Yuxweluptun, and many others.

Ecofeminist legacies are also an important presence throughout the exhibition, with 51 percent of participating artists identifying as female, including many foundational eco-feminists such as Lita Albuquerque, Agnes Denes, Mary Miss, Mierle Laderman Ukeles, Meg Webster, and Hannah Wilke. Ecofeminists of younger generations are also present to underscore an intergenerational dialogue.

Designed to extend *Into the Time Horizon*'s reach beyond the museum's walls, the exhibition is formally accompanied by a playlist, **101 Songs for the Environment**, which encompasses a vast scope of musical voices that have similarly considered the effects of a changing environment over time. Apsara DiQuinzio, Andrea and John C. Deane Family Chief Curator, developed the thematic playlist to play inside the museum throughout the course of the exhibition. The entire playlist is accessible online and reproduced in the exhibition catalogue, enabling visitors to continue the experience at home.

"Music, like visual art, has the unique ability to touch the hearts and minds of its listeners. The philosopher Susanne Langer likened it to the highest form of art because it enables people to grasp an inner emotional life that is otherwise difficult to articulate, making it an essential aspect of human consciousness," DiQuinzio asserts. "At this moment in time we need to assemble as many inspirational and creative voices as possible to amplify awareness about our urgent ecological moment."

The exhibition also features a robust film and video program, screening daily in the Museum Theater from March 28 through November 1, 2026.
